

## Paper Tulip Tutorial

## Supplies Needed:

Coffee Filter
Scissors
Glue
Tweezers
Florist Wire
Standard Hole Punch
Ball Stylus or Paintbrush
Mouse pad or Foam Deli Tray
Small piece of Styrofoam
Small Container to hold Tulips
Paints- green, brown & your choice
of color for Tulip petals.





The main components are painted coffee filters, from which you punch circles and cut out leaves, and florist wire. The leaves are roughly 1-1/8" long.

Use a ball-ended tool or the end of a paintbrush and make circular motions to make the circle curve up to look more like a tulip petal. This needs to be done on a slightly spongy surface...like a mousepad or foam deli tray.
